Competition Categories

Categories are for each show. All trophies are awarded by the Editors of *Easyriders Magazine*, with the exception of the People's Choice Award, which is decided by public vote.

Best of Show - One bike will be crowned the BEST of the BEST in each city & invited to compete for BIKE OF THE YEAR at the invitational show in Charlotte, NC on January 26 & 27.

John Green Award - John Green was at the helm of Easyriders Events for well over a decade and loved nothing more than the truly old school, "well-seasoned" bike. The winner of this award will be invited to compete at the invitational show in Charlotte, NC.

People's Choice (1st-3rd) - Spectators decide this one! Bikes with the most votes overall are invited to compete at the invitational show in Charlotte, NC.

Editor's Choice - Winner invited to compete at the invitational show in Charlotte, NC.

Radical Bagger (1st-3rd) - State-of-the-art custom touring bikes. 1st place in each city invited to compete at the invitational show in Charlotte, NC.

Radical Custom (1st-3rd) - One-off, wild ground-up customs. 1st place in each city invited to compete at the invitational show in Charlotte, NC.

Modern Chopper (1st-3rd) - Evo, Twin Cam and Milwaukee Eight Motors.

Street Custom (1st-3rd) - Mild customs to high performance street machines.

Specialty Class (1st-3rd) - Unusual customs, metric bikes, other marqueses.

Best Paint - From old school flames to high tech murals.

Best Display - Create an eye-catching display or convey a theme.

Custom Sportster - Modified XL.

Modified Stock Bagger (1st-3rd) - Factory touring bikes with minor frame mods allowed.

Modified Stock Street (1st-3rd) - Factory street bikes with minor frame mods allowed.

Old School Bobbers (1st-3rd) - 1960's style custom bobbers.

Old School Choppers (1st-3rd) - 1970's style custom choppers.

Antique Class (1st-3rd) - Pre-1984 restored and vintage motorcycles.
